Bubble Gum Experiment

In this experiment you will be trying to find out how the amount of sugar in the gum affects how long the bubble lasts.

Procedure:

- 1. Gather the following materials:
 - Two pieces of gum (1 regular and 1 sugar free)
 - Ruler
 - Assistant
- 2. Unwrap one piece of gum, place it into your mouth and chew it until you can make a bubble with it.
- 3. Blow a bubble with the gum. Have your assistant time the bubble from

- 4. Record the results in your individual data table.
- 5. Repeat steps 3 & 4 until you have blown five bubbles.
- 6. Repeat steps 2-5, adding one more piece of gum, until you have used 3 pieces of gum.
